Ordinance No. 2013- 2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE BOROUGH'S PARKING ORDINANCE, NO. 261 ENACTED SEPTEMBER 17, 2012, TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOROUGH PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHEN AUTHORIZED BY BOROUGH COUNCIL MAY INSTITUTE ON BEHALF OF THE BOROUGH SUMMARY CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS BEFORE A MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUDGE WHERE A PARKING TICKET REMAINS UNPAID FOR OVER 120 HOURS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Newburg Borough Council as follows.

Section 1. Paragraph D of Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2012- 261, enacted September 17, 2012 establishing parking regulations and enforcement procedures for violations of the Ordinance, is amended to read as follows.

Section 6. Enforcement of Ordinance and penalties for parking violations.

D. If the \$15.00 is not paid or mailed within the 120 hours after the parking ticket was issued, the Mayor or when authorized by Borough Council, the parking enforcement officer shall institute with the local Magisterial District Judge summary criminal proceedings against the owner of the vehicle for a fine of \$50.00 plus the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. All other Newburg Borough ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed.

Section 3. Savings Clause. In all other respects, the ordinances of the Borough of Newburg shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.




