RESOLUTION NO. 2020-022**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG APPOINTING KEN RIFE AS A MEMBER OF BOROUGH COUNCIL TO FILL THE VACANCY IN OFFICE CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF RICHARD LAUGHLIN.

WHEREAS, Borough Council Member Richard Laughlin has submitted his letter of resignation from Borough Council which was accepted by Council at it's July 20, 2020 meeting; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Laughlin was elected as Council Member of the Borough in December 2016 for a four year term which would end on the first Monday in January 2022; and

WHEREAS, the resignation of Mr. Laughlin has created a vacancy on Borough Council which Borough Council has the authority to fill in accordance with Section 901 of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has deemed it in the best interest of the Borough to appoint Ken Rife as a member of Borough Council for until the first monday in January after the next municipal election; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rife is a registered elector of the Borough and has been a continuous resident of the Borough for over one year; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council deems Mr. Rife to be qualified to serve as a member of Borough Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Borough of Newburg as follows:


1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference hereto.


