RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 012

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG APPOINTING MELISSA NEGLEY AS MAYOR TO FILL THE VACANCY IN OFFICE CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF NICHOLAS SPENCER.

WHEREAS, Mayor Spencer was elected as Mayor of the Borough of Newburg in November 2017 for a four year term which would end on the first Monday in January 2022; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Spencer has resigned as Mayor effective June 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned resignation has created a vacancy in the Office of Mayor which Borough Council has the authority to fill in accordance with Section 901 of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has deemed it in the best interest of the Borough to appoint Melissa Negley as Mayor until the first Monday in January 2020 when the individual elected as Mayor in the November 2019 election takes office; and

WHEREAS, Melissa Negley is a registered elector of the Borough and has been a continuous resident of the Borough for over one year; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council deems Melissa Negley to be the best qualified candidate to serve as a Mayor.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Borough of Newburg as follows:

2. Melissa Negley is appointed to serve as Mayor until the first Monday in January 2020 when the individual elected as Mayor in the November 2019 election takes office.


