## A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO APPOINT A MEMBER TO THE ZONING HEARING BOARD

WHEREAS, the Borough of Newburg (the "Borough") has enacted a Zoning Ordinance and established a Zoning Hearing Board in accordance with the requirements of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10101 et seq. ("MPC"); and

WHEREAS, Section 903 of the MPC provides that members of the Zoning Hearing Board are to be appointed by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Zoning Hearing Board member Sharon Spencer's term expired on January 1, 2019 and desired to accept a reappointment for a three (3) year term; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to reappoint Sharon Spencer to the Zoning Hearing Board for a (3) year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Newburg, County of Cumberland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that:

Section 1. Pursuant to § 903(a) of the MPC, 53 P.S. § 10903(a), the Borough Council of the Borough of Newburg hereby reappoints Sharon Spencer as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board of the Borough of Newburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania with the term of office to expire on January 1, 2022.

Section 2. In the event any provision, section, clause, or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutionally shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution it being the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough that the remainder of the Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective as of January 7, 2019.
